A DAY IN THE DELAWARE

Water Gap – A distinctive notch in the Appalachian Mountains



From miles away, a distinctive notch in the Appalachian Mountains draws the eye. Delaware Water Gap has beckoned vacationers to the Pocono Mountains for centuries, and the town's community has been making those guests feel at home for generations, ever since the founding of the borough in 1793. In fact, Delaware Water Gap is the source of the name of the whole region; "Pocono" is a Native American word meaning "stream between two mountains."

Many visitors pass through Delaware Water Gap on their way into the Pocono Mountains, but those in the know stop and stay awhile to enjoy the many things to do in the Gap. With a host of hiking, kayaking and rafting adventures,

delicious restaurants, quaint shops, a vibrant jazz scene, historic inns and family-friendly camping, there's a lot to love about Delaware Water Gap.

Edge of the Wood Outfitters on Main Street offers adventure gear, bike rentals for a cycle along the McDade Recreational Trail, and canoe and kayak river trips out on the Delaware River. Once you've worked up an appetite in the fresh air, there are plenty of spots to eat in Delaware Water Gap.

Homemade pies beckon from the Village Farmer and Bakery on Broad Street, while prime meats are the star at nearby Joe Bosco Smokehouse BBQ. Pull up a seat at the Sycamore Grille to enjoy daily pub specials. Deer Head Inn is perfect for an evening of fine dining and music. Known as the oldest continuously-running jazz club in the country, the Deer Head Inn is at the heart of the annual Delaware Water Gap COTA Celebration of the Arts Jazz & Arts Festival.

The borough has been home to a vibrant community of musicians since Victorian



times when John Philip Sousa performed for summer vacationers at the Historic Castle Inn. Today, the Shoppes at Castle Inn house a collection of creative businesses, including an old-fashioned ice cream parlor, art gallery, toyworks, candy cavalcade, and skincare and spa. Journey into Delaware Water Gap's past when you step aboard the seasonal Pocono Historic Trolley Tour which departs from The Castle Inn, which also served as a trolley stop for visitors a century ago. The Antoine Dutot Museum & Gallery, open weekends Memorial Day through Columbus Day and named after the borough's founder, is the perfect place to learn even more about the rich history of the area.

Whether you're planning a hiking trip along the Appalachian Trail or a canoeing or kayaking expedition on the Delaware River, make sure you spend some time exploring Delaware Water Gap. Scan the QR code above for even more day trip ideas.



ENTERING MONROE COUNTY



Known as the “heart of the Poconos,” Monroe County and its county seat of Stroudsburg offer both dynamic downtown energy and striking scenic beauty, with a central location right off I-80. Get away from it all at peaceful mountain retreats, attend a seasonal festival, shop ‘til you drop, discover exciting attractions and new development projects, and much more.

Lovers of outdoor adventure have a wide array of fresh-air activities and destinations to choose from in Monroe County: hike along the famed Appalachian Trail or seek out Hidden Lake in Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area, take a woodland walk at Kettle Creek Environmental Education Center, or get a birds-eye view that stretches across three states in Big Pocono State Park. Lovers of history can step back in time at Quiet Valley Living Historical Farm, which showcases what life was like on a 19th century Pennsylvania German farmstead. Quiet Valley’s events calendar includes fun like the Farm Animal Frolic, the Pocono State Craft Festival, Harvest Festival, and Old Time Christmas.

When you’re ready for some action, head into Stroudsburg to explore walkable, historic streets filled with modern murals, quaint shops, happening boutiques, plus restaurants and wineries. Start your day with a creative twist on breakfast classics at The Cure Café or enjoy authentic Mexican cuisine at Del Tacos. Dress to impress with a new ensemble from The Apple Tree or stock up on fishing supplies and camping gear at Dunkelberger’s Sports Outfitter. Pocono Soap is perfect for delightfully-scented gifts, while visitors can make memories as well as cupcakes, cookery, and crafts during a custom class at the Main Street Makery.

Experience the tastes and sounds of the area during the Monroe Farmers Market or Live Music in Courthouse Square, which take place on select dates throughout the year. These are just a few of the free seasonal events happening in Stroudsburg! Enjoy the Annual St. Patrick’s Day Parade, the Snowmen of Stroudsburg, WinterFest on Presidents’ Day Weekend, StroudFest on Labor Day Weekend, and more. The iconic Sherman Theater also brings in great acts, concerts, comedy shows, and events.

While Monroe County is already home to major venues like Pocono Raceway, Mount Airy Casino Resort, Camelback Lodge & Aquatopia Indoor Waterpark, and Kalahari Resorts and Conventions, new expansions and new properties are in the works as well. The popular Pocono Premium Outlets,

previously known as the Crossings Premium Outlets, is receiving an upgrade this year, and a multi-million-dollar expansion is underway at Great Wolf Lodge, adding new villas and dining plus additional rooms and waterslides to the family-friendly resort. A new upscale, eco-friendly property, The Swiftwater Hotel will be built just a stone’s throw from the hibachi restaurant Desaki. A proposed new passenger rail project is also gathering steam and seeks to reestablish train service from New York City to Scranton, with stops in Stroudsburg and other Monroe County towns.

Even one the oldest, most storied buildings in the area is getting some love and refurbishment. Built in 1795 by the founder of Stroudsburg, Revolutionary War Colonel Jacob Stroud, the Stroud Mansion was where Jacob’s son Daniel lived as he helped to oversee the development of the town and community. Now the headquarters of the Monroe County Historical Association and currently open for public tours, the historic home will soon have a new addition, providing room for a new lobby, museum shop, meeting space, exhibits, and archive storage.

GREAT OUTDOORS

Whether on the ground or in the air, there are endless opportunities for fun.



The Pocono Mountains is known for its unspoiled natural beauty, and there are so many ways to get out and breathe in the fresh air. From the serene to the adrenaline-inducing, find the perfect outdoor adventure to match your group's mood and abilities. Check out 10 activities to try below, ranked from peaceful and pastoral to thrilling and action-packed. Remember to be a good steward of the great outdoors and leave no trace on the environment you're enjoying.

1. Horseback Riding

Saddle up! Hit the forest trails and discover the peace of the Poconos while horseback riding. Both families and single riders can reconnect with nature and make a new four-legged friend. At Bushkill Riding Stables in East Stroudsburg, you'll find friendly staff members and mounts ready to guide you on a scenic ride. Happy Trails Stables in Waymart has over 100 acres of trails waiting to be explored.

Never tried horseback riding? No worries! Mountain Creek Riding Stable in Cresco loves beginners. Whether planning a ride with a small group or alone, no experience is required. At Daisy Field Farm in White Haven,

you can also try hay wagon, carriage, and pony rides.

2. Boating

While in the Poconos, you have to get out on the water! Cruise along our rivers and lakes and catch beautiful reflections of the surrounding mountain slopes rippling in the water. Visit one of our parks, such as Mauch Chunk Lake Park or Tobyhanna State Park, to launch your own boat year-round from dawn until dusk. Don't forget life jackets!

Looking for boat rentals? There are plenty of options! During the warmer months, choose a vessel to captain for a day at Rubber Duckie Boat Rentals on Lake Wallenpaupack. Leave the steering to your guide and learn about the lake's history when you take a leisurely guided cruise with Wallenpaupack Scenic Boat Tours.

3. Fishing

With 122 miles of stocked rivers and 11,285 acres of stocked lakes, you'll wonder why you haven't fished the Pocono Mountains sooner. Fishing requirements vary by location. Pay lakes like Paradise Trout Preserve in Cresco and Big Brown Fish & Pay Lakes in Effort do not require a fishing license, while public waters and state parks, like Promised Land State Park, do require a license by PA Fish and Boat Commission laws. Numerous options, including one, three and seven-day tourist permits, are available for visitors.

Statewide trout fishing season begins April 1, 2023. Guided fishing trips are available from outfitters like Captain Joe's Fishing & Waterman Services, operated out of Lake Harmony. Whether you're an avid angler or a beginner, trips can be customized to fit your experience, time, and budget.

4. Hiking

Over 126 hiking trails cover over 261 miles of Pocono Mountains beauty, including a portion of the famed Appalachian Trail ascending Mount Minis. Hike throughout the area and discover paths leading to panoramic views and majestic waterfalls. Don't miss your chance to visit Bushkill Falls, "The Niagara of Pennsylvania," as well as Pennsylvania's tallest and second waterfalls, both located within Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area.

Looking to learn more about the scenery you're passing through? Find a quiet walk at local nature preserves and education centers like the new Van Scott Nature Reserve of the Delaware Highlands Conservancy in Beach Lake or the Lehigh Gap Nature Center in Slatington.

5. Biking

The two national and nine state parks in the Poconos total over 100,000 acres and offer bike paths ranging in difficulty and distance. Rentals and shuttle services are available throughout the region, making biking a breeze.

Pedal through the Delaware Water Gap along the McDade Recreational Trail for a mountainous biking excursion or set out for a cycle in the Jim Thorpe area on the Switchback Railroad Trail or along the Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor. Up the ante and experience the Bike Train on select dates: board the Lehigh Gorge Scenic Railway for a train ride up the Gorge for 25 miles, then bike back down to Jim Thorpe at your own pace.

6. Air Tour

You may have visited beloved spots in the Poconos like Delaware Water Gap and Lake Wallenpaupack, but have you ever seen them from a bird's-eye view? Get an aerial perspective of the region's stunning scenery throughout the seasons: Pocono Helitours and Moyer Aviation offer air tours year-round!

Soar over winding waterways and tree-covered mountains on a popular flight plan or customize your own sightseeing excursion. There's nothing like seeing a sunrise or sunset from up in the sky. Buckle up for a private tour and an experience you won't forget.

7. Adventure Park

Can't get enough of the trees? Play up amongst them! Get your adrenaline pumping at an adventure park. Test your skills on treetop ropes courses, rock climbing walls, hillside tube slides, and more.

At Blue Mountain Resort's Summit Aerial Park, guests can choose from four levels of difficulty, while adventurers at Gorilla Grove Treetop Adventures at Kalahari Resorts & Conventions and The Adventure Center at Skytop Lodge will find in-air obstacles to navigate.

8. River Trips

For unmatched views of the region, take a canoe or kayak down the Delaware River. Book a trip with one of our many guides like Edge of the Woods Outfitters, Shawnee River Trips, Chamberlain Canoes, Adventure Sports or Lander's River Trips.

Ready to kick things up a notch? Sign up for an afternoon of whitewater rafting! Pocono Whitewater's Big Day Out packs

three big adventures into one epic outing on the Lehigh River. Raft, bike and hike your way through the region select dates April through October. Equipment and meals are provided.

9. Paintball

Battle it out beneath the trees to see who will bring home bragging rights. The 700-acre facility at Skirmish Paintball is the world's biggest paintball park, with over 50 playing fields to try, perfect for challenging friends and family to a round.

The Paintball Asylum in Tannersville welcomes everyone from first-time visitors to experienced paintballers. At Pocono Mountain Paintball in Nesquehoning, warriors will play on fields with streams, hills, hollows, trenches, buildings, oak flats, and more. You can even combine your paintball package with whitewater rafting, biking, or...

10. Zip Line

Fly through the trees on a zip line, either riding solo or racing a friend down the mountain! The 900-foot zip line at Whitewater Rafting Adventures and Pocono Mountain Paintball in Nesquehoning is more than eight stories high.

Feel your adrenaline pumping as you zip through the sky on the 1,000' Double Barrel Zipline at Camelback Mountain Adventures or take a gentler ride with beautiful forest views with Pocono Zip Racer in East Stroudsburg.

How many of these top 10 outdoor adventures will you try? From the new leaves of spring to the colorful foliage of fall, from the sunny days of summer to the snowy days of winter, outdoor fun is a different experience in every season. Start planning that return trip to discover all the excitement and majesty of the great outdoors in the Poconos!

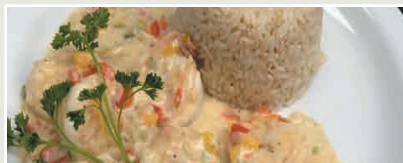

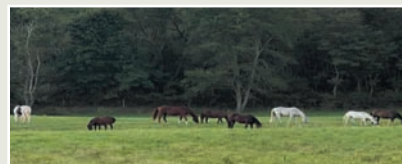

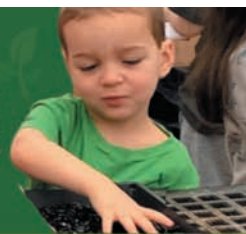

ENTERING WAYNE COUNTY



Tucked away in the upper northeastern corner of Pennsylvania, Wayne County is home to pastoral farms, meandering rivers, vibrant small towns, and historic railroad ties.

As you drive through the winding backroads of Wayne County, it's impossible to miss the region's bucolic and picturesque small farms. The area has long been known for its agricultural roots, and today's farmers proudly carry on the legacy of working the land. The fifth generation of the Bryant family at Highland Farm and Calkins Creamery focus on happy cows, the freshest milk, and artisan cheeses, which have taken home first place in national and international cheese competitions and are used at high-end restaurants in New York City. "Other small creameries maybe concentrate on two or three cheeses, but we have a pretty broad spectrum," shares owner Bill Bryant.

Over in Waymart, the Robinson Family Farm has been providing the community with natural beef and nutrient-dense vegetables for over 100 years. "My values always come back to this farm and my

family," notes fourth-generation owner Zack Jones, who also works for the Wayne Conservation District, helping to ensure that farms throughout the region maintain good soil nutrients and clean water.

A passion for homesteading and self-sustainability led Stan and Amy, the husband-and-wife team behind Bialecki Farms in Lakewood, to start a small business through their hydroponics greenhouse. "It's coming back to the small, local family farms," says Amy. "You see the restaurants, they're interested in the farm-to-table, getting that from the local farms."

One of those restaurants is Native, located on Honesdale's Main Street, where chefs fashion the Bialecki greens and other farm fresh food into gastronomic works of art. A few blocks north, shoppers can purchase produce directly from farmers every Saturday at The Main Street Farmers Market at The Cooperage Project. "The Coop," which recently celebrated its tenth anniversary, provides the community with fresh flavors and fresh ideas, serving as a hub for local programming and classes of all kinds.

Between Native and The Cooperage Project, the Wayne County Historical Society and the next-door train station are

both hubs in their own right. Known as the "Birthplace of the American Railroad," Honesdale welcomed the first steam locomotive to run on commercial tracks in the United States in August 1829. A full-size, 1920s replica of the "Stourbridge Lion" is on display in the museum, while train enthusiasts can hop aboard The Stourbridge Line for rail excursions throughout the year. The vintage railroad coaches follow the bends of the beautiful Lackawaxen River, connecting the small towns of Honesdale and Hawley.

A train journey isn't the only way to experience the magic of the Lackawaxen River; anglers and boaters will soon have more opportunities to enjoy this Wayne County waterway. New development of the Lackawaxen River Trails aims to complete three additional river access points in Honesdale, Indian Orchard, and White Mills by 2023-2024, complete with ADA parking.

Whether you're paddling along the river, riding on the train, walking downtown, or exploring the fields of local farms, there's so much to discover in Wayne County. Scan the QR code below to browse even more attractions, restaurants, and shops throughout the area.

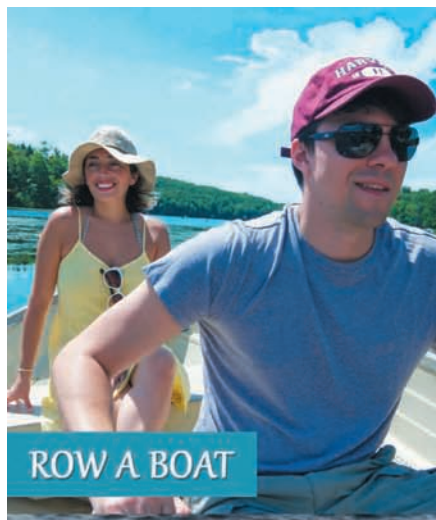

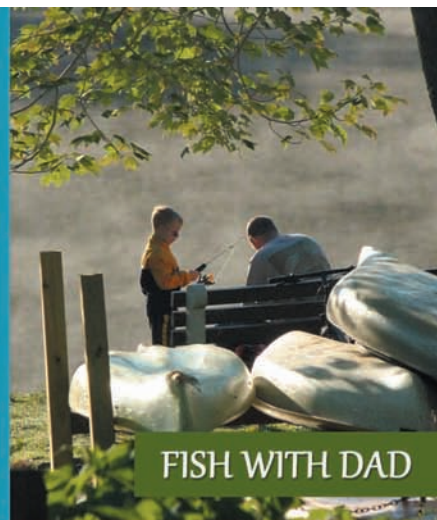

WON ENTERING PIKE COUNTY



Stretching from the banks of the Delaware River to sprawling Lake Wallenpaupack, Pike County boasts not one but two National Historic Landmarks within its county lines. From rich cultural heritage to nature's grandeur to exciting events, there's so much to experience.

Atlantic Magazine once described the town of Milford as the "prettiest county seat in America," and the charming, storybook streets have been designated a National Historic District. The Milford Hospitality Group is dedicated to preserving landmark properties around town, from technology upgrades at the Milford Theater and Performing Arts Center to revamped accommodations at the Tom Quick Inn. The latest venue added to its roster is Forest Hall, which recently hosted a pop-up exhibition featuring never-before-seen photographs of Andy Warhol.

Built in 1904 to house classrooms for Yale University's Forest School, Forest Hall is part of the legacy that the Pinchot family left on Milford. Grey Towers National Historic Landmark, located in the hills just above town, was once the Pinchot's

summer home. In the early twentieth century, Gifford Pinchot pioneered the idea of sustainable harvesting of natural resources and became the first head of the U.S. Forest Service under Teddy Roosevelt. When President John F. Kennedy dedicated Grey Towers as a National Historic Site in 1963, he referred to Pinchot as the "Father of the Conservation Movement." Guided mansion tours are available on select dates, but the grounds are open for self-guided tours from sunrise to sunset, year-round, seven days a week. Pinchot planted an impressive array of trees on his property in the 1920s, and he once remarked, "By George, I wish I could come back 100 years from now and see my trees." Don't miss the chance to marvel at the magnificent Copper Beeches, Japanese Maple, Sakhalin Spruce and more that Pinchot dreamed of seeing!

From the past to the present, 2022 saw the opening of the newly-renovated, 200-acre Poconos Park in Pike County. In its first year, the 10,000-seat amphitheater welcomed world-class acts like Lynard Skynard plus Brett Young and Brantley Gilbert, headliners for the Cowboy Luau. "It's the beginning of a dream come true. We're looking forward to bringing everyone in to have a good time with us," says John Oakes, the CEO and Founder of From the Roots, the company which now owns Poconos

Park. But big-name concerts aren't the only big draws on Pike County's annual events calendar. Visitors also love the Milford Music Festival in June, the Milford Writers & Readers Festival in September, and Black Bear Film Festival in October, just to name a few.

Whether you're enjoying a seasonal festival or strolling through historic streets, you're never far from natural beauty in Pike County. One third of the county is made up of state or federal park or game land, offering plenty of opportunities for hiking along scenic trails. Raymondskill Falls, the tallest waterfall in Pennsylvania, is located just three miles from downtown Milford. The Delaware River is also never far away, and Pike County's second National Historic Landmark, the Roebling Aqueduct Bridge, is located along the Upper Delaware in Lackawaxen. Built in the heyday of the Delaware & Hudson Canal by the same engineer who later designed the Brooklyn Bridge, this structure, also a National Civil Engineering Landmark, is the oldest existing wire suspension bridge in the U.S.

TOURISM GIVES BACK

Learn about local organizations and initiatives
that are making a difference in the Poconos



Vacationers come from far and wide to enjoy the inspiring natural beauty and rich history of the Pocono Mountains, but the strength and warmth of communities throughout Wayne, Pike, Monroe, and Carbon counties are what truly make the Poconos such a wonderful place to visit again and again. Local tourism attractions and businesses have close ties to their next-door neighbors and seek to give back in myriad different ways.

"Being able to use our facility and our presence in the world of sport to better this community is something that's extremely important to us," shared Ben May, President of Pocono Raceway, which welcomes NASCAR races and close to 100,000 fans to "The Tricky Triangle" track every summer. In the

fall, Pocono Raceway partnered with Pocono Mountain Harley-Davidson in Tannersville to give motorcyclists the opportunity to take a lap around the iconic track. The proceeds from the event benefited the VALOR Clinic Foundation, which aids local veterans in need with assistance, shelter, and resources.



"It's been a tough time financially recently," said VALOR founder Mark Baylis. "I can't tell you how grateful we are for what they do for us."

Local businesses pitch in however they can, whether that's offering the use of a racetrack or donating freshly-picked produce. In Carbon County, the harvest from the Farm at Blue Mountain's two growing houses and seven-and-a-half acre field goes not only to Blue Mountain Resort's restaurants and catering, but also to local food banks like the West End Food Pantry. "It's really important to give back to our community because we depend on each other to be successful and to support one other," said Blue Mountain's horticulturalist Katie Taylor. West End Food Pantry Director Karena Thek shared that the yield from the farm, which includes peppers, okra, and leeks, provides a greater variety of tastes and flavors to those that use the food pantry.

From summer bounty to winter slopes, when the historic Poconos ski resort Jack Frost Mountain and Big Boulder Ski Area was upgrading the property's chair lifts, they seized the opportunity to raise funds for nearby Lake Harmony Fire and Rescue Squad. "They serve us and keep us safe 24/7, so we're excited for the opportunity to give back," said General Manager Trent Poole. The original chair lifts were auctioned off, with proceeds benefiting local first responders. The auction has raised more than \$50,000. Nick's Lake House also supports Lake Harmony Fire and Rescue during their Annual Parade of Boats event. The fundraiser started 30 years ago and features prizes, live music, and more.

Mount Airy Casino Resort in Monroe County spreads the love to the community throughout the year. During the holidays, Mount Airy partnered with a local Shoprite, and resort staff became elves for the afternoon, surprising random shoppers by picking up their grocery bills. In addition to providing support to organizations like Meals on Wheels and The Salvation Army, the popular casino also looks to help the four-legged residents of the area. Mount Airy recently donated a truckload of bed linens and towels to Camp Papillon Animal Shelter. Animals awaiting adoption will now be snuggling up in fine Egyptian cotton from the luxurious, AAA Four-Diamond resort.

Over in Pike County, family-run Woodloch Resort puts on three annual charity events including a 5K, golf tournament, and a "tricky tray" fundraiser in support of cancer research and patient care. A cancer survivor himself, Woodloch's co-owner Bob Kiesendahl formed a foundation called BK Hope Cures which has given back over \$1.5 million

so far. Woodloch also seeks to be a good steward of the local environment, participating in the Green Lodging Partnership. With every reservation, guests at participating hotels contribute directly to the Delaware Highlands Conservancy and the protection of clean waters and healthy lands.

Michael Coppola, organizer of the grass-roots "Keep Hawley-Honesdale Beautiful" program, credits local businesses with contributing to the success of working to keep Wayne County clean and green. "Knowing that we have the community support keeps us going, that we have the money behind us to buy supplies, safety equipment. It makes us feel like a team. It brings us together. Having the support of East Shore Lodging and Woodloch and others, this is huge."

Properly disposing of litter is a priority and focus for the entire region. Twice a year, volunteers from all four counties gather for "Pick Up the Poconos" days. Since the program's start in 2018, close to 30,000 bags of litter have been picked up and properly disposed of through various Pick Up the Poconos campaigns, which stretch beyond the biannual clean-up days to programs like Pocono 3C. Formed in June 2019, the Pocono Community Caring Company, also known as Pocono 3C, was created in partnership with the Pocono Mountains United Way, RHD's Street2Feet Outreach Center and the Monroe County Municipal Waste Management Authority. The program is designed to give persons who are homeless, or in danger of becoming homeless, a job and case work to help them get back up on their feet. To date, nearly 30 participants have obtained housing, a vehicle, and/or a permanent job through participation in Pocono 3C.

While litter clean ups help to keep trash out of area parks, the Pocono Mountains Visitors Bureau Community Impact Grant, now in its second year, goes an extra step, providing funds to upgrade playgrounds, enhance outdoor recreation facilities, rehabilitate historical buildings, and more. The PMVB awarded a total of \$292,055 in the grant's inaugural year to local governments, agencies, and organizations to help fund a variety of projects that aim to improve the quality of life in communities throughout Wayne, Pike, Monroe, and Carbon counties.

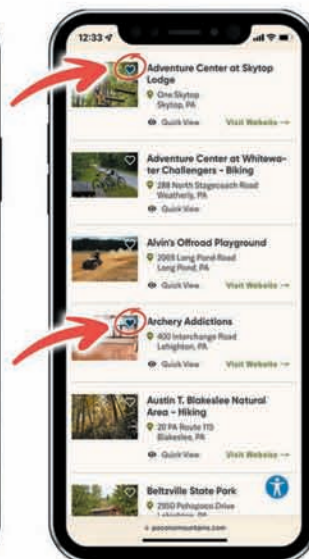
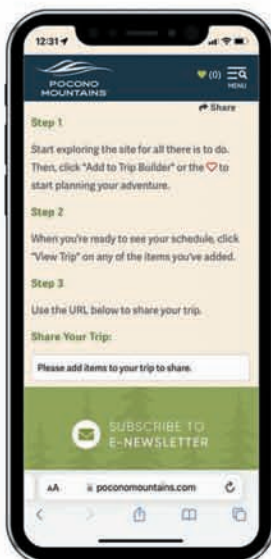
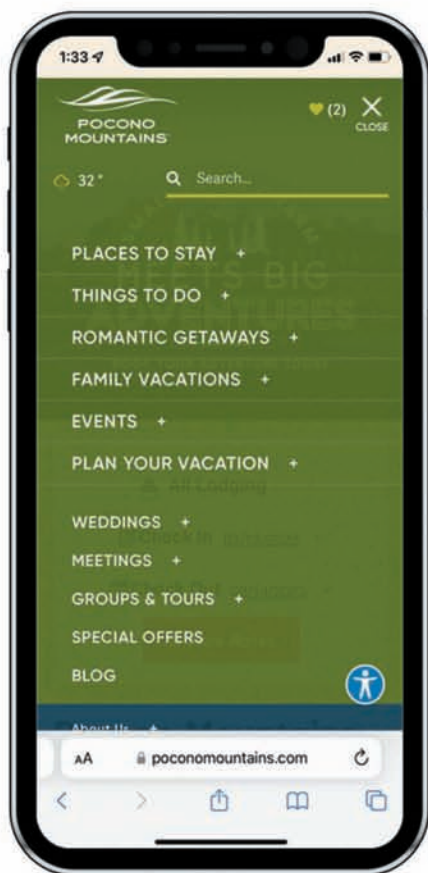

ENTERING

CARBON COUNTY



The western gateway to the Poconos region, Carbon County is home to historic Jim Thorpe, the “Switzerland of America.” Offering both the charms of a European village and the thrills of a mountain sports destination, this Victorian town and the surrounding area are a favorite destination for visitors from around the world.

Once known as Mauch Chunk, Jim Thorpe has a history stretching back over 200 years and was home to over a dozen industrialist millionaires in the 19th century. But Jim Thorpe is only the beginning when it comes to happening small towns in Carbon County. Lehighton is only a stone’s throw away and has unique downtown businesses and shops, easy access to the D&L Trail, plus plentiful free parking. The spacious outdoor amphitheater behind Lehighton Borough Hall was recently refurbished and hosts fun community events like the Annual Rocktoberfest every fall. Nearby in Colonel Jacob Weiss Park, the Lehighton Downtown Farmers Market welcomes area growers, makers, and sellers on select Saturdays.

Take a stroll along Lehighton’s First Street to discover eclectic and nostalgic candies at Jenny’s Sweets and More, a board game library and escape room at Jokers Are Wild Game Café, holistic wellness services at Within Harmony, plus delicious food and a vintage 1930s atmosphere at Bonnie & Clyde Pub and Grill. Check off another location on your Pocono Beverage Trail trek with a visit to Wine & More on 1st.

Just west of Jim Thorpe and Lehighton beyond Mauch Chunk Lake Park is the small town of Lansford. Once used to transport coal out of the region, Lansford’s historic freight train station is over 100 years old and currently undergoing a major revitalization. Anthracite coal played a major role in the history of Carbon County, and at the No. 9 Coal Mine & Museum in Lansford, you can hop in a mine car and travel 1,600 feet into the mountain for a first-person glimpse of the past. For over a decade, the No. 9 Museum has been celebrating the Annual Coal Miner’s Heritage Festival every summer, a unique, fun, and educational event perfect for a family day out.

Mining in Carbon County was discontinued in the 20th century, and today local businesses seek to develop and expand in a responsible way, focusing on pro-

tecting natural resources. The Carbon County Nature and Commerce Committee encourages the rehabilitation of historic buildings and emphasizes the importance of clean water for both locals and visitors. Whitewater rafting along the Lehigh River and hiking and biking in Lehigh Gorge State Park are major draws in Carbon County, but the outdoor adventure doesn’t stop there.

Nearby ski slopes like Jack Frost Mountain, Big Boulder Ski Area, and Blue Mountain Resort are a haven for skiers, snowboarders, and snow tubers every winter. All three ski areas are under recent new ownership and boast additions like new chair lifts and new runs. The Farm at Blue Mountain Resort began planting in the spring of 2021 at the foot of the property’s popular ski slopes, and the seasonal fresh produce is now used for catering and at the Slopeside Pub and Grill. The Farm at Blue Mountain is also available for meetings, events, and team building tours in the fresh air.
